ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BRIDGE CITY, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 5, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRIDGE CITY IDENTIFYING NEW BOUNDARIES FOR LIVESTOCK; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the City of Bridge City routinely receives complaints concerning livestock being a nuisance to adjoining property owners within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of Texas, including those found in Chapter 51 of the Texas Local Government Code, provide the City authority to adopt ordinances for good government, peace, order, and welfare of the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGE CITY, TEXAS:

That Ordinance No. 74-8 of the CITY OF BRIDGE CITY, TEXAS, SECTION 1, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner, possessor or keeper of any cow, bull, steer, calf, horse, mule, sheep, goat, poultry or other livestock to keep or possess said livestock within 50 feet of any property line.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this Ordinance shall be cumulative of other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this Ordinance.


