No serving of crawfish is allowed at this facility.

Only residents of Bridge City and Orangefield School Districts may reserve the Pavilion.

NOT RESPONSIBLE: We are not responsible for the injury of anyone at the City facility or in the parking lot of the facility. Children are welcome guests and are a delight to have at the facility but must be under adult supervision at all times.

Political meetings of any type are prohibited. The facilities may be used, however, by an individual who currently holds political office, with constituents who reside within the corporate boundaries of the City of Bridge City, whose primary purpose is to inform their constituents of the status of matters that relate directly to the office holders office and directly impact the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Bridge City. In any circumstances, fundraising under this section is prohibited (Amended by City Council per minute action at the August 20, 2013 City Council meeting).

Sales of any type are prohibited unless they are for the exclusive benefit of a 501(c)3 organization (proof required), school-sponsored student organization, or a City of Bridge City-sponsored event. These functions must first be approved by the City administration.

Inflatable recreation devices are strictly prohibited unless their use is specifically approved by the City Manager of Bridge City and proof of liability insurance, covering the use of the device and naming the City of Bridge City as an additional insured, is provided and approved in the amount sufficient to cover any injury as determined by the City Manager.

Occupants shall not create an unreasonably dangerous circumstance by their use of the facility. Such use is strictly prohibited and may result in the expulsion of all participants.

Outside electrical usage will be paid for by the Renter. Pricing will be set by the City Administration depending on activity and electrical usage.

BRIDGE CITY PARK

Rules and Operation

- No alcohol.
- No fire unless used for cooking in a pit grill, or other container manufactured for cooking with open flames. No cooking under the pavilion. No cooking of fish, crawfish, or seafood. No Serving of Crawfish.
- No swimming, wading or otherwise entering or upon any body of water.
- No dogs or other domesticated animals, without a leash.
- Do not abandon any animal.
- Do not interfere with, disrupt, or prevent the orderly conduct of any City sponsored, hosted, or approved community event or program.
- No glass containers.
- No bicycles, skateboards, skates, rollerblades or motor vehicles at the pavilion or other structures located in the City Park.
- No vandalizing City property/structures.
- No cutting trees, shrubs, plants grass or turf.
- No polluting waters.
- The speed limit is 10 miles per hour.
- Parking in designated areas only.
- No double parking.
- No operating motorized vehicles on any area outside a road or parking area.
- Abusive language and unruly behavior will be cause for ejection from the park.

SPLASH PARK

Rules and Operation

- Operating hours are 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., 7 days a week. Splash Park is closed November through April of each year.
- Splash Park is for Local Residents Only.
- To start, touch the red activator on the pole at the right corner of the Splash Park. The features will activate and run through a cycle for about 3 minutes. When they stop, touch the activator again to reactivate the features.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult, the age of 18 years or older, at all times while in the Splash Park.
- It is recommended to wear water shoes to prevent slipping and protect feet.
- Infants should wear a rubber liner or swim diaper.
- Please walk, do not run.
- Do not climb on spray features.
- Do not place hands, face, or objects near or on spray water openings.
- No rollerblades, skateboards, scooters bicycles or any motorized vehicles on the Splash Pad.
- No glass containers allowed in the park.
- Alcohol consumption is prohibited.
- Abusive language and unruly behavior are prohibited.
- Splash Park must be cleared at the first sight of lightning or the sound of thunder.
- No fires, charcoal grills, fire pits or other cooking devices within 25 feet of the Splash Park pad.
- Do not interfere with, disrupt, or prevent the orderly conduct of any City sponsored, hosted, or approved community event or program.
- No vandalizing of City property/structures.
